1) Joining the OEMConnect Community

- a) Mentors and Mentees interested in joining the OEMConnect Community may do so at any time by registering with Digital Human Library.

2) Your Commitment

MENTORS

- a) OEMConnect Mentors agree to:
 - i) be contacted by potential Mentees
 - ii) respond to requests made by Mentees (*whether you are able to commit to a conversation or not*)
 - iii) arrange a mutually agreeable number of meetings (*virtually or face to face*)
 - iv) arrive at meetings on time
 - v) provide support as needed
 - vi) be open to new learning
 - vii) treat others with kindness, empathy and respect
 - viii) complete an entrance survey and feedback surveys at various intervals



MENTEES

- b) OEMConnect Mentees agree to:
 - i) contact potential Mentors based on your learning needs
 - ii) respond to Mentors (*whether you are able to commit to a conversation or not*)
 - iii) arrange a mutually agreeable number of meetings (*virtually or face to face*)
 - iv) arrive at meetings on time
 - v) be open to new learning
 - vi) treat others with kindness, empathy and respect
 - vii) complete an entrance survey and feedback surveys at various intervals
